BLACK COUNTRY MUSEUM – MONDAY 10TH JUNE 2019

We have arranged a History trip for Year 8 to the Black Country Museum on Monday 10th June 2019. The visit is in the context of the history studied by Year 8 students on the Industrial Revolution. We shall be visiting a coal mine, experiencing a Victorian lesson and taking a canal trip to explore the importance of the canal system to the Industrial Revolution.

The coach will leave **Spalding Bus Station** (Winfrey Avenue) at 7:00am (please ensure that your child arrives at least 10 minutes before) and our estimated time of return to **Spalding Bus Station** at 6:00pm. Please be advised that staff will only be able to wait for 10 minutes after arriving back at **Spalding Bus Station**. In the event of an emergency, you can use the School mobile, 07948 012590. Please note, however, that this number is used for emergencies and should not be used for any other reason.

Girls should wear non-uniform, provided it is deemed suitable for a school trip, they should wear comfortable shoes. A packed lunch should be brought with them and snacks for the return journey if they wish.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £27.00, which is for transport and the cost of the museum and canal trip. This payment should be made by **Wednesday 22nd May at the latest**.

Methods of payment

- On-line: **The preferred method of payment is on-line**; there will be a permission tick box which should be ticked before payment is made to allow your daughter to attend this event. (There is no need to return a paper copy of the reply slip when permission box has been ticked online)
- Cheque: Made payable to 'Spalding High School' placed in an envelope posted into the Finance Office letterbox. Please ensure your daughter's name, form and trip title, are written on both the back of the cheque and on the envelope and include the signed permission slip below.
- Cash: **Exact cash must be handed directly to Ms Kent in the Finance Office** with the reply slip below. **Do not put cash payments into the Finance Office letter box.**

Pupil Premium funding is available for this trip if you are entitled to it. If you daughter is eligible for this funding, please tick the box on the reply slip below.

Since the School does not have the funds to subsidise trips, if they are not fully funded by parents, then I am afraid that they will not be able to run. Please note that no refunds will be available. Should you have any queries regarding payment, please contact the Headmistress in confidence.
