From the start of this term we became an Operation Encompass School, becoming part of a national scheme which runs jointly between all schools and the police.

Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced any domestic abuse.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the School's staff – the Designated Safeguarding Lead, is trained to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared. This will be in confidence, while ensuring that the School is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children or their families.

At Spalding High School, the Designated Safeguarding Lead is Mrs Lara Ray and the Deputy Safeguarding Lead is Mrs Amanda Schwarz.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
