We are looking forward to welcoming you to our **Sixth Form Taster Day on Monday 21st January**. Please arrive by 8.55am and make your way to the sixth form common room.

You will attend a tutor period with a current sixth form tutor from 8.55am-9.30am, during which you will receive information about the day and be able to ask any questions you may have. It is also an opportunity to get to know other students who will be in your year from September 2019 onwards.

From 9.30am-10.15am there will be an opportunity to find out more about our enrichment programme, including core mathematics and work experience. For any students who are new to the school, there will also be an opportunity to go on a tour of the school at this time.

The four remaining periods will be spent in taster A Level lessons, subject choices for each period can be found on the reverse of this letter.
