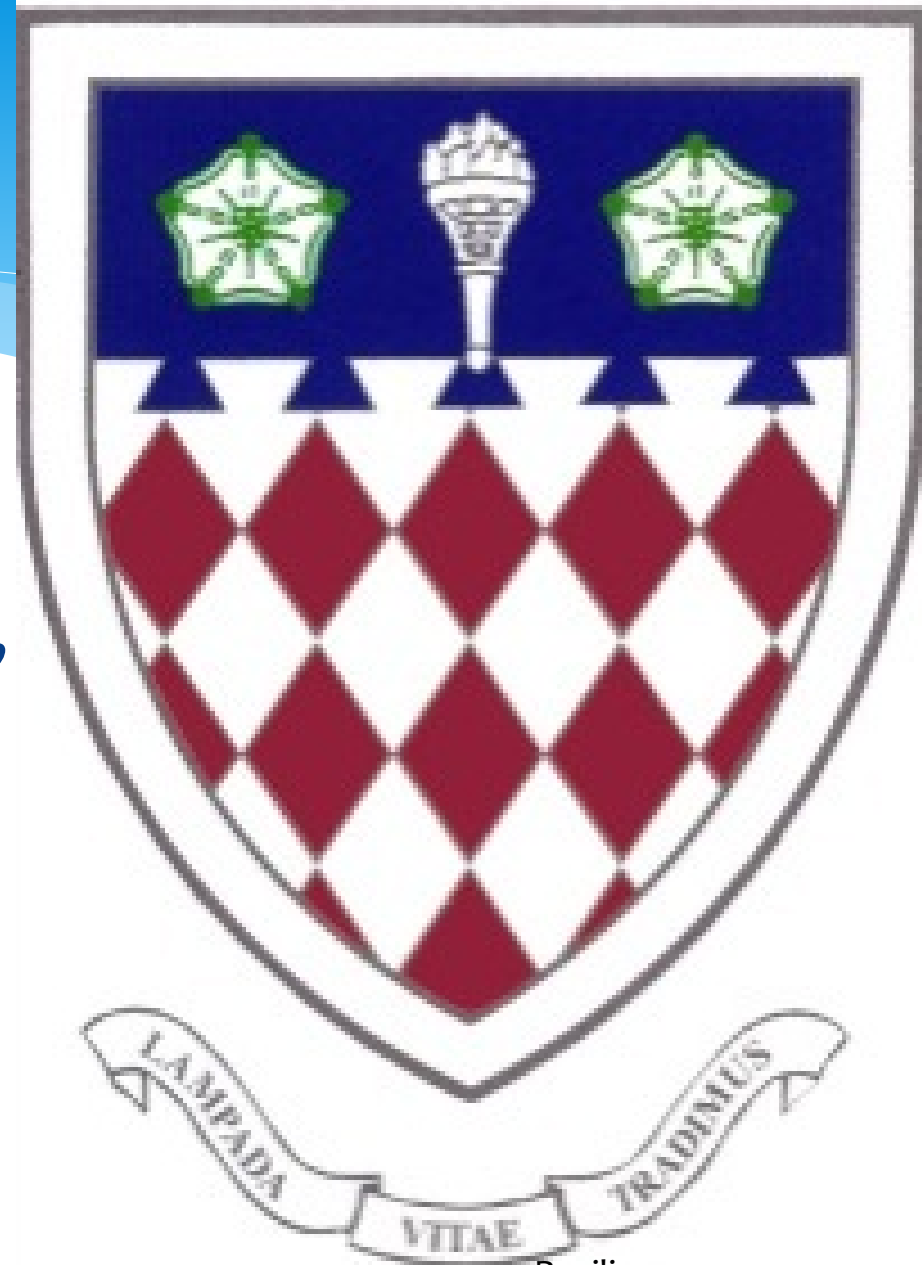

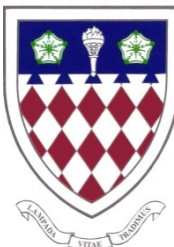

COURSE AIMS

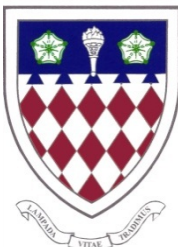
1. To develop an understanding of the English language and its roots.

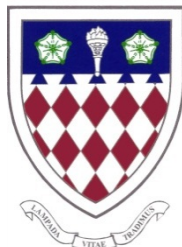

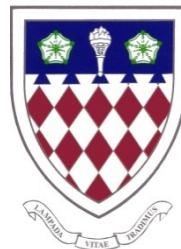
LINGUISTIC MERITS

- **LATIN is the original ESPERANTO – the original international language of Europe.**
- **- Studying Latin supports learning:**
 - **FRENCH and SPANISH as they are ROMANCE languages**
 - **GERMAN because of similar features in GRAMMAR and syntax**
 - **ENGLISH because 60% of English words are derived from Latin – even more when considering science specific vocabulary**

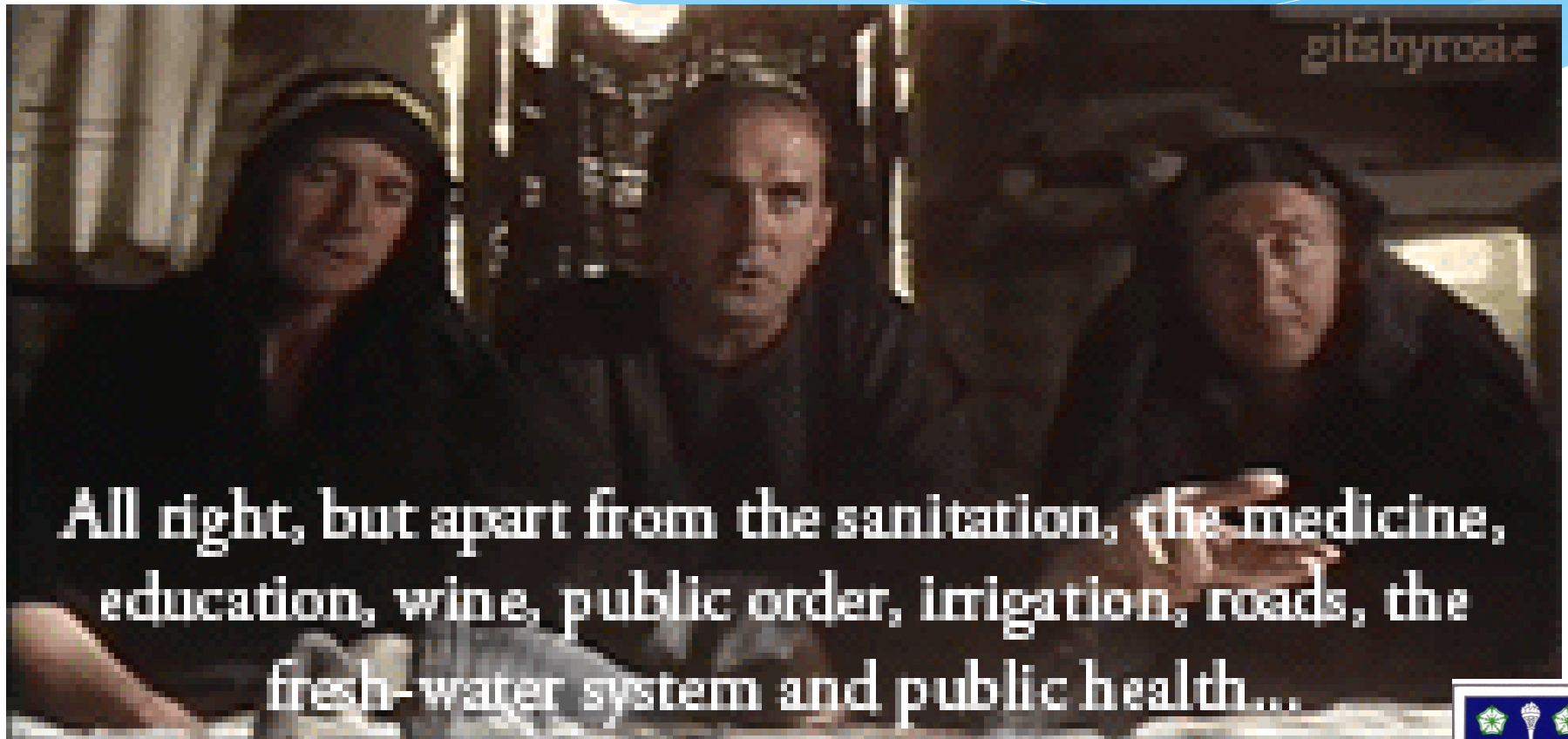

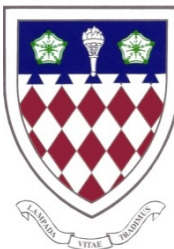
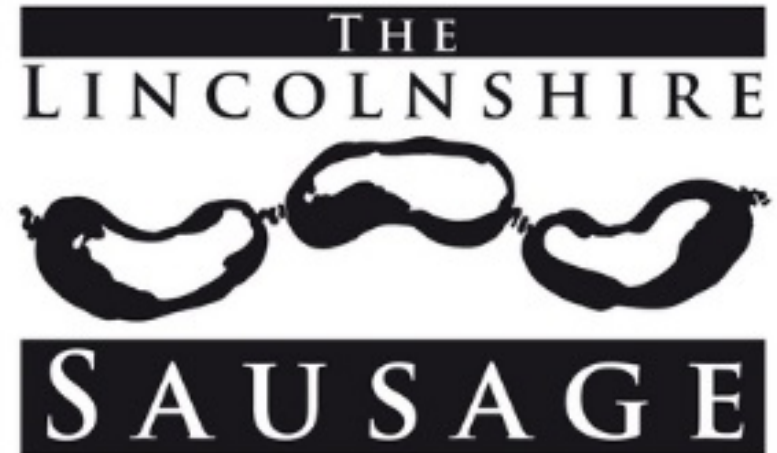
Even our local cultural heritage has been influenced by Latin

Lindum the Romans formed from “llyn”

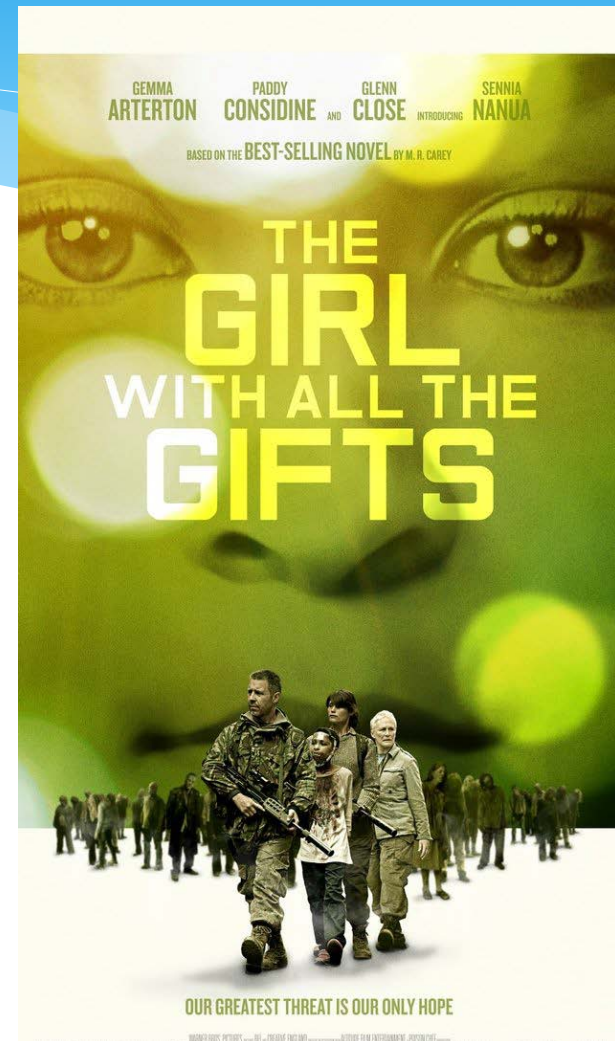
Coln from colonia – a settlement of Roman veterans

The word “sausage” comes from “salsus” meaning “salted”

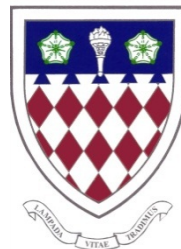


LITERATURE & LITERACY

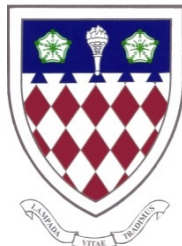


LITERATURE & LITERACY

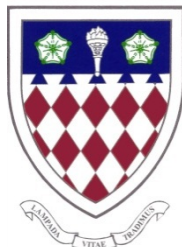


Relevance to today...

- * Rome was ruled by megalomaniac leaders..

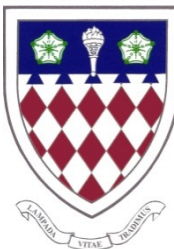
Beyond year 8
