**Hall & Sports Hall Assemblies:** will be lead and/or fronted by HOYs. Week 1 assemblies are HOY, Form Tutors and form group assemblies. Week 2 are KS assemblies and delivered by the SLT, other staff and guest speakers. An assembly rota, entrance and exit arrangements and seating plan will be implemented and followed.
